Crossroads Prison Ministries has a need for more volunteer mentors for an increasing number of students enrolling in correspondence Bible study courses. As a Crossroads mentor you will review prisoners' lessons and respond to them with words of hope and encouragement. You will hear their stories and have an opportunity to let them know they are not forgotten and that they are deeply loved by God. Most mentors do one lesson per week which usually takes about 1 hour and you can do it right from your home. Answer keys are provided for each lesson. It is an excellent way to be a doer of the word as well as a hearer, James 1:22. I was a prisoner and you came to visit me, Matthew 25:36.
